Dear Colleagues,

We hope that we find you all well and in good health in the ongoing crisis related to COVID-19. As you might remember, last summer we eventually had to decide to postpone the 4<sup>th</sup> CAA-GR conference 'Computer Applications and Quantitative Methods in Archaeology, Greece', which was initially planned to be held at N.C.S.R. "Demokritos" in October 2020. After all it turned out that it would not have been possible to organize a conference hosting a larger number of participants at the N.C.S.R. "Demokritos" campus under the circumstances of the COVID-19 crisis at that time. The situation, however, has not really improved since then. Nevertheless, in view of the running vaccination program and other measures there is realistic perspective that until Autumn this year it will be possible again to organize conferences including physical presence of participants. For this, we decided to give it another try and would like to invite you for the 21<sup>th</sup>/22<sup>nd</sup> October 2021. This will be the definite date, though, without another postponement. In the case that the pandemic situation has not clearly improved until then impeding, still or again, hosting of participants at N.C.S.R. "Demokritos" we will organize the conference as a purely virtual event. In any case, we are considering possibilities for presentations and conference participation via Internet, but we are looking forward to gathering a considerable number of participants in person.
